



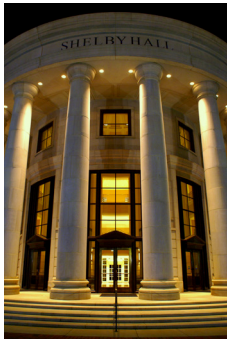

Opened in 2007, the Shelby Center advances Auburn University’s position as one of the nation’s leading engineering programs. Consisting of a central structure with two L-shaped wings and two stand-alone buildings wrapped around a central courtyard, the building houses research laboratories, classrooms, lecture halls and offices for the Department of Computer Sciences, Industrial, Mechanical and Systems Engineering. The design by HOK takes advantage of the interest provided by the “hands-on” nature of these labs, helping to attract students to Auburn’s varied engineering programs.

CWRU WEATHERHEAD GRADUATE SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT, CLEVELAND, OH

The design of the CWRU Weatherhead Graduate School of Management building reflects the distinctive sculptural approach of its renowned architect, Frank Gehry. Its striking façade utilizes curvaceous structures, intersecting forms and reflective materials. Equally unconventional, the building’s interior features intimate spaces juxtaposed within the commodious circulation paths and common areas designed to encourage student-faculty interaction.

Built on the coastline of the Red Sea, the King Abdullah University of Science & Technology is a 36 million SM university, commercial and residential complex. The expansive development is comprised of a range of academic buildings, research facilities and labs, innovation and technology centers, convention facilities, mosques, recreation areas and residences. CD+M’s site and master plan lighting design for the project included roads, parking, landscaping, iconic architecture and public art. The site is slated to accommodate 20,000 people.
